

## Valencia County Board of County Commission Resolution 2020- 43

## A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE 2020-2021 NEW MEXICO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION LOCAL GOVERNMENT ROAD FUND PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners acted in its regularly scheduled meeting on July 15<sup>th</sup>, 2020 to accept the 2020/2021 Local Government Road Fund; and requests the New Mexico Department of Transportation (NMDOT) to accept the same; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the County Commission to prioritize road improvements based on road conditions, classification and the needs of its citizens; and

WHEREAS, the NMDOT has requested that Valencia County utilize all available funding sources at its discretion for County road improvements; and

WHEREAS, it is to the benefit of the citizens of the County for the County Commission to upgrade its road system, and endorse an aggressive Road Improvement Program; and

WHEREAS, Valencia County and the New Mexico Department of Transportation entered into a Cooperative Agreement for Control No. HW2-L300256 with a total project cost of \$178,064.00; Valencia County's proportional matching share shall be 25% or \$44,516.00 and New Mexico Department of Transportation's share shall be 75% or \$133,548.00. Valencia County shall pay all costs which exceed the total amount of \$178,064.00.

WHEREAS, Valencia County and the New Mexico Department of Transportation entered into a Cooperative Agreement for Control No. HW2-L300274 with a total project cost of \$156,207.00; Valencia County's proportional matching share shall be 25% or \$39,052.00 and New Mexico Department of Transportation's share shall be 75% or \$117,155.00. Valencia County shall pay all costs, which exceed the total amount of \$156,207.00.

WHEREAS, Valencia County and the New Mexico Department of Transportation entered into a Cooperative Agreement for Control No. HW2-L300277 with a total project cost of \$264,000.00; Valencia County's proportional matching share will be 25% or \$66,000.00 and New Mexico

Valencia County Clerk

Department of Transportation's share shall be 75% or \$198,000.00. Valencia County shall pay all costs which exceed the total amount of \$264,000.00.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the governing body of Valencia County that:

- 1. The 2020-2021 County Road Improvement Program is of a high priority and is predicated off current needs and road conditions
- 2. The County will enter into Cooperative Agreements Control Number HW2-L300256, HW2-L300274 and HW2-L300277 with the New Mexico Department of Transportation for Local Government Road Fund Projects for year 2020 - 2021 to improve the roads defined under the attached sheets which are within the control of Valencia County in Los Lunas, New Mexico.




