

VALENCIA COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS Resolution No. 2023- //

PARTICIPATION IN CAPITAL OUTLAY PROGRAM ADMINISTERED BY NEW MEXICO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION

WHEREAS, the Valencia County and the New Mexico Department of Transportation enter into a Cooperative Agreement.

WHEREAS, the total cost of the project will be **\$250,000.00** to be funded by the parties hereto as follows:

a. New Mexico Department of Transportation's share shall be 100% or \$250,000.00

and

b. Valencia Counties proportional matching share shall be 0% or \$0.00

TOTAL PROJECT COST IS \$250,000.00

Valencia County shall pay all costs, which exceed the total amount of \$250,000.00

Now therefore, be it resolved in official session that Valencia County determines, resolves, and orders as follows:

That the project for this Cooperative agreement is adopted and has a priority standing.

The agreement terminates on June 30, 2026 for Laws of 2022 SB212, Chapter 53, Section 36, Subsection 96 and the Valencia County incorporates all the agreements, covenants, and understandings between the parties hereto concerning the subject matter hereof, and all such covenants, agreements and understandings have been merged into the written agreement.

NOW therefore, be it resolved by the *Valencia County* to enter into Cooperative Agreement Control Number *C322178* with the New Mexico Department of Transportation for Capital Outlay Laws of 2022 SB212, Chapter 53, Section 36, Subsection 96 to *plan, design and construct roads projects Valencia within* the control of the *Valencia County* in Los Lunas, New Mexico.
