

## VALENCIA COUNTY BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS RESOLUTION № 2024-51

## DESIGNATING THE LOCATION OF ELECTION DAY POLLING PLACES FOR ALL STATEWIDE ELECTIONS IN 2024 AND 2025; REVISING RESOLUTION 2023-53

**WHEREAS**, the Board of County Commissioners met upon notice of meeting duly published on July 17, 2024 at 5:00 p.m. in the Valencia County Administration Building, 444 Luna Avenue, Los Lunas, New Mexico 87031; and,

**WHEREAS**, on the 19<sup>th</sup> day of July, 2023, pursuant to the New Mexico Statutes Annotated 1978, Section 1-3-2, in Resolution 2024-53, the Board of County Commissioners designated the location of election day polling places in the county for the conduct of any statewide election conducted in calendar years 2024 and 2025; *and* 

WHEREAS, the County Clerk has advised that it is in the best interest of the electorate to revise the resolution; *and*,

**WHEREAS**, the Board of County Commissioners finds that each polling place designated in this resolution complies with the provisions of NMSA 1978, Section 1-3-7, titled Polling Places; *and*,

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners finds that those precincts that are consolidated to create Voting Convenience Centers meet the requirements of NMSA 1978, Section 1-3-4, will be available to voters of any precinct in the county to cast a vote at the Voting Convenience Center, will make voting more convenient and accessible to voters of the consolidated precinct, will not result in delays for voters in the voting process, and are centrally located within the consolidated precinct; *and*,

**WHEREAS**, the Board of County Commissioners finds that that each polling place provides individuals with physical mobility limitations unobstructed access to at least one voting machine; *and*,

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Board of County Commissioners designates the polling locations for the 2024-25 elections are revised as follows:

**NOW, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT**, the polling location portion of Resolution 2023-53 is repealed and replaced with the adoption of this resolution, however the remainder of Resolution 2023-53 relating to the Board of Registration shall remain unchanged.
