

## Valencia County Board of County Commissioners Resolution 2024- 74

## A RESOLUTION AMMENDING THE 2023-2024 NEW MEXICO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION LOCAL GOVERNMENT ROAD FUND PROGRAM

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners acted in its regularly scheduled meeting on November 6<sup>th</sup>, 2024 to amend the 2023/2024 Local Government Road Fund; and requests the New Mexico Department of Transportation (NMDOT) to accept the amendments; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the County Commission to prioritize road improvements based on road conditions, classification and the needs of its citizens; and

**WHEREAS**, the NMDOT has requested that Valencia County utilize all available funding sources at its discretion for County road improvements; and

WHEREAS, Valencia County did have cost savings on the Ladera Road Milling project and will be utilizing the savings on the Sandhill Road and NM263 design project due to increase in design fees; and

WHEREAS, it is to the benefit of the citizens of the County for the County Commission to upgrade its road system, and endorse an aggressive Road Improvement Program; and

WHEREAS, Valencia County and the New Mexico Department of Transportation previously entered into a Cooperative Agreement for Control No. HW2-L300348 (SB) with a total project cost of \$286,964.00; Valencia County's proportional matching share will remain at 25% or \$71,741.00 and New Mexico Department of Transportation's share shall be 75% or \$215,223.00. Valencia County shall pay all costs which exceed the total amount of \$286,964.00.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED,** by the governing body of Valencia County that:

- 1. The 2023-2024 County Road Improvement Program is of a high priority and is predicated off current needs and road conditions.
- 2. The County will amend the Cooperative Agreements Control Number HW2-L300348 SB with the New Mexico Department of Transportation for Local Government Road Fund Projects for year 2023 2024 to improve the roads defined under the attached Exhibit 1 per the eligible project scopes as indicated in the 2014 LGRF Handbook and are within the control of Valencia County in Los Lunas, New Mexico.


## **EXHIBIT 1**

Valencia County FY24 Local Government Road Fund Projects HW2 - L300348 - SB

- The North NM 47 & NM263 (El Cerro Loop) Intersection Design. This project is anticipated to utilize the SB funding source. The scope of the project will consist of the following:
  - Project Design
  - Project Topographic Survey of the site
  - Geotechnical Survey
  - Utility Research
  - · Aerial Imagery
  - Right of Way Limits
  - Assessment of Intersection Configuration
  - Evaluation of existing conditions
  - Traffic counts and queuing video recording and evaluations with design to account for the increase in traffic



- 2. The Ladera Road Mill and Seal Project funding and the limits will be from Square Deal Road to Dee Court for 1.2 miles. This project is anticipated to utilize SB funding source in combination with the CAP allotted funding. The scope of the project will consist of the following:
  - Removal of unsuitable material
  - Subgrade prep.
  - 4" milling placement & testing
  - Sealing



- 3. The Sandhill & NM263 (El Cerro Loop) Road Improvement Design. This project is anticipated to utilize the COOP funding source. The scope of the project will consist of the following:
  - Project Design
  - Project Topographic Survey of the site
  - Geotechnical Survey
  - · Utility research
  - Aerial Imagery
  - · Right of Way limits
  - Assessment of Intersection Configuration
  - Evaluation of existing conditions
  - Traffic counts and queuing video recording and evaluations with design to account for the increase in traffic
