AUTOMOTIVE MECHANIC

JOB SUMMARY:

Performs complex malfunction diagnosis, maintenance, and repairs to a wide range of motorized vehicles, to include automobiles, fire engines, senior vans, heavy and light trucks, graders, and other motorized road repair equipment.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- 1. Performs main engine, engine ignition, fuel system, and engine emission control system diagnosis and repair for fleet vehicles and road equipment. Includes both gasoline and diesel equipment.
- 2. Performs diagnosis and repairs on transmissions to include transaxle and transfer case systems.
- 3. Performs complex diagnosis and repair of suspension, steering and alignment and brake systems on various fleet and road construction equipment.
- 4. Performs complex general electrical and electronic system diagnosis and repair.
- 5. Performs all phases of maintenance required for fleet vehicle operation.
- 6. Test drives all vehicles repaired.
- 7. Ensures proper care in the use and maintenance of equipment and supplies; promotes continuous improvement of workplace safety and environmental practices.
- 8. Employee must have own tools.
- 9. Completes all necessary paperwork on all jobs.
- 10. Performs miscellaneous job-related duties as assigned.

MINIMUM EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE REQUIRED:

High school diploma or GED and at least 2 years of experience that is directly related to the duties and responsibilities specified.

PREFERRED KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, AND ABILITIES:

- Knowledge and understanding of the operating characteristics and maintenance requirements of a wide range of motorized vehicles and equipment.
- Ability to use automotive diagnostic equipment and hand and power tools.

- Ability to diagnose, repair, and maintain automotive vehicles and various types of equipment along with associated sub-systems.
- Ability to test drive all vehicles.
- Ability to perform complex automotive vehicle maintenance and repairs.
- Ability to read, understand, follow and enforce safety procedures.

LICENSURES AND CERTIFICATIONS REQUIRED:

- Must be certified as an Automotive Technician or Equivalent.
- Certified is required in areas required by City, State, and/or Federal Agencies (i.e. Freon Recovery/Emission Inspection, etc.).
- Possession of a valid New Mexico driver's license is a requirement for this job.

OTHER CONDITIONS OF EMPLOYMENT:

- Ability to perform essential functions and adapt to working conditions.
- No history or pattern of reckless driving, DWI/DUI or irresponsible driving in the last three years.
- No history of felony misdemeanor conviction involving moral turpitude, violence, distribution of controlled substance or dishonesty.

WORKING CONDITIONS:

- Work involves considerable exposure to unusual elements, such as extreme temperatures, dirt, dust, fumes, smoke, unpleasant odors, and/or loud noises.
- Requires heavy lifting, pushing, or pulling required of objects over 50 pounds.
- Work involves some exposure to hazards or physical risks, which require following basic safety precautions.
