Open burning rules

New in 2014:

All locations in Valencia County have new burn hours

What you can burn

Brush
Leaves
Weeds
Crop waste
Grass clippings
Untreated wood



NOTRASH BURNING

You must stay with your burn and make sure it is completely out before you leave.

If you are having trouble controlling your burn, call 911.

What you need to do

You must call on the day you want to burn to find out if burning is allowed that day.

If you live in Valencia County, City of Belen, City of Los Lunas, Rio Communities, Bosque Farms, and Peralta, you must call (505) 866-2036 each day you want to burn. You may call outside of business hours and on weekends.

If you live in Belen or Los Lunas:

You must get a written burn permit from your Fire Department. It is good for 30 days. Each day you want to burn, you must call (505) 866-2036.

If you live in Bosque Farms:

You must get a written burn permit from the Village Office. It is good for 2 weeks. Each day you want to burn, you must call (505) 866-2036.

If you live in Peralta:

Each weekday you want to burn, you must call (505) 866-2036.
