

Inmate Accounts

Valencia County Detention Center provides several ways for family/friends to make funds available to inmates. We accept Money Orders at the front lobby Monday thru Friday 8 A.M.-3:00 P.M.

Visitation Schedule

Visitation days are determined by inmate's housing and is scheduled as follows:

A-Pod (Segregation Unit)

Fridays Only

B-Pod

Mondays & Wednesdays

C-Pod/Female Unit/Honor Dorm

Tuesdays & Thursdays

Visitation times are in the morning from 8:00am-10:30am and in the afternoon from 12:00pm-1:30pm.

Segregation Hours run from 8 A.m.-1:30 P.M.

Visitor Dress Code

Visitors will not be allowed to wear the following items when entering the facility:

- Hats
- Sunglasses
- Jackets
- Shorts/Skirts
- Tank Tops (including spaghetti straps)
- Tops exposing the midriff area
- Open sandals
- Clothing promoting gang activity
- Clothing promoting drug paraphernalia
- Any other clothing which the staff deems as inappropriate for visitation in a correctional facility

**** This dress code applies to everyone, including children, who enter the facility to visit.**

**** Any visitor attempting to bring contraband into the facility will have their visits terminated and charges may be filed.**

Property Release

Valencia County Detention Center requires a written request be submitted by the inmate to the Warden or Deputy Warden. Once an approval has been obtained, only the person(s) listed may pick up the property by showing a valid picture ID.

Inmate Mail

Inmates are permitted to send and receive correspondence. Anyone wanting to send mail should address letters as follows:

Letters containing contraband will be returned to sender. Inmates are not allowed to receive items such as:

- Stamps
- Blank envelopes or paper
- Paper clips or staples
- Magazine articles or newspapers
- Inappropriate pictures or Polaroid pictures
- Stickers (to include address labels) or glue
- Cash, checks, or money orders
- Anything gang related
- Blue or black in only

- No makeup/lipstick or perfume

**** There is a maximum of 10 pictures allowed per letter.**

Visitation Policy

Valencia County Detention Center is dedicated to providing an effective visiting program that encourages inmates to maintain family communication while satisfying the facility's security requirements. In order to accomplish this, we have certain policies/procedures that visitors shall abide by.

Inmates will be in charge of their visitation list. Forms are available in housing units.

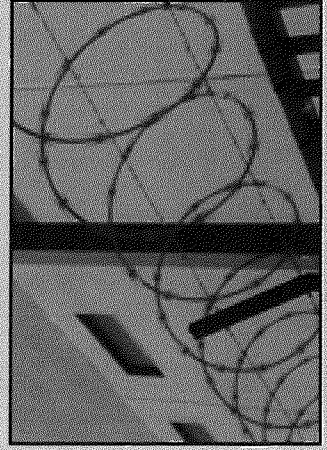
A. five people per list, children are not included in the five

B. list can only be changed after six months of incarceration

Once list is in file, individuals on list are required to bring identification. Visitors 16 years and older are also required to surrender identification upon signing in for visitation.

Visitation forms will be filled out and approval or disapproval will then be granted.

No visitor under the age of 18 will be allowed to visit without first having been properly identified and accompanied by a responsible parent or guardian.
