57	Background: The property owner requested to come before the board after renewing her business				
58	license. The business will have two employees. Department reviews were handed out March 6, 2018

72	surrounding area, there are no complaints and suggested that the renewal does work.				
73	<u>Commissioner Draszkiewicz:</u> Stated she is quite impressed, that if there were no complaints from				
74	neighbors she didn't see any reason not to approve the request.				
75	<u>Commissioner Baca</u> : What happens when the dogs get noisy?
