#### VALENCIA COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS

#### **BUSINESS MEETING**

#### **DECEMBER 4, 2013**

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- 1) The meeting was called to order by Chairman Eaton at 5:00 P.M.
- 2) Mike Vinyard led the Pledge of Allegiance.
- 3) Approval of Agenda

Commissioner Romero moved for approval. Seconded by Commissioner Aragon. Motion carried unanimously.

4) Approval of Minutes: November 13, 2013- Public Hearing Commissioner Andersen moved for approval. Seconded by Commissioner Aragon. Motion carried unanimously.

## **DISCUSSION (NON-ACTION) ITEM(S):**

5) Commissioners, Committees and Reports.

Commissioner Aguilar reported that she along with Commissioner Aragon, Mr. Telles, Glenda Chavez and Hoss Foster were present at a meeting held last night by the Core of Engineers about their study to certify the levees along the Rio Grande which would then remove us from the flood plain. There will also be a community meeting on December 10<sup>th</sup> at 6:30pm at the Tome Fire Department, the purpose of the meeting to be conducted by Fire Chief Gonzales is to gain public input regarding proposed changes to the Open Burn Ordinance.

Commissioner Andersen stated that she had a recent discussion with Mr. Norbert Schueller and one of the things that she had learned is that if the commission decides to re-impose the correctional GRT they need to approve an ordinance at least 60 days prior to March 15, 2014 or it will not take effect July 1, 2014. Commissioner Andersen remarked that we need to start informing the public why this money is desperately needed for the county and that it would be exclusively used for the Detention Center. She would like this item placed on the agenda for next week's meeting to vote on the publication of an ordinance.

Mr. Telles commented that County Manager interviews will all be on Friday the 6th so the Special Meeting scheduled for Thursday the 5th will be canceled.

## 6) Discussion with Assessor. Viola Vallejos-Garcia

County Assessor Viola Vallejos-Garcia stated that properties in the county are assessed every 3 years, new construction in the county is picked up by the Assessors as it comes in. Commissioner Andersen asked if the Assessor's office was aware of any multiple sales of the small, unimproved lots with taxes at \$5 per lot because a number of sales would be needed to justify setting a minimum tax rate higher than the current amount of \$5. Chief Appraiser Orlando Montoya stated that in order to get passed the \$5 minimum tax rate the properties would need to be assessed at close to \$5,000 per lot and there is no way that those small lots would be worth that much. Currently there are about 200,000 properties that the county is responsible for assessing. Ms. Vallejos stated that the following are tax exemptions that the county offers to the taxpayers Head of Household, Veterans, 65 Years and Older, and Agricultural Lands.

Ms. Bouska stated that that \$38,000 would be the amount that the county would need to contribute and that amount has been budgeted.

Commissioner Aguilar moved for approval. Seconded by Commissioner Andersen. Motion carried unanimously. (See Exhibit A)

# 8) Consideration of 2013-14 CAP-3-14 (496) Cooperative Agreement with New Mexico Department of Transportation. *Kelly Bouska*

Ms. Bouska stated that \$32,943 would be the amount that the county would need to contribute and that amount has been budgeted.

Commissioner Andersen moved for approval. Seconded by Commissioner Aragon. Motion carried unanimously. (See Exhibit B)

## 9) Consideration of Resolution 2013-\_\_\_ Opposing Animal Killing Contests. *Commissioner Alicia Aguilar*

Commissioner Aguilar stated that she had been contacted by some of her constituents and other residents of the county regarding the animal killing contests and these individuals are concerned that these types of contests place themselves and their property in danger, so it is a health and safety issue. They are also concerned about the negative image and bad reputation that Valencia County gets from the contests being held here. Commissioner Aragon asked that if this resolution is passed if it was just an opinion of the county or would there be any enforcement by the law. Attorney Nance stated that it was just a resolution so it would just be an opinion of the governing body; it has no force of law.

The individuals speaking in favor of the resolution included Elisabeth Dicharry, Jim Trever, Raymond Watt, Darrell Trammell, Lisa Durkin, Guy Dicharry, Judy Babcock, Phil Carter, Virginia Smith, and Lauren Wells. The individuals speaking in opposition to the resolution included Donald Chavez, Mark Chavez, and Gail Goodman.

Commissioner Aguilar moved for approval of the resolution. Seconded by Chairman Eaton. Motion failed 2-3. Commissioners Aragon, Andersen and Romero voted no.

Chairman Eaton called for a 5 minute break.

## 10) Appointment of Hearing Officer for Wisenant Appeal. Adren Nance

Mr. John A. Myers from Myers, Oliver and Price was the individual suggested by the parties opposing each other in the appeal and Attorney Nance is requesting the commissioner's approval to appoint Mr. Myers as the Hearing Officer.

Commissioner Aguilar moved for approval. Seconded by Commissioner Andersen. Motion carried unanimously.

11) Consideration and approval of Disposal of Certain County Property. *Michael Vinyard* Mr. Vinyard presented the commissioners with 2 lists of items, put together by the Disposal Committee, to be disposed of. The items are from the I.T. Department and Public Works. It was agreed upon that in order to satisfy the audit findings after the items are disposed of the Disposal Committee will follow up with the commission and present another list of the items that were actually disposed of and a list of the money that was generated from the possible sale of items.

Commissioner Aguilar moved for approval. Seconded by Commissioner Andersen. Motion carried unanimously. (See Exhibit C)

#### **COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT**

THIS COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT entered into this	day of	,2013
between the NEW MEXICO DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORT.	ATION ("Depart	ment") and the
County of Valencia, ("Public Entity").		

In consideration of the covenants contained herein and pursuant to Sections 67-3-28 and 67-3-28.2 NMSA 1978 and Commission Policy No. 44-12, THE PARTIES AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

## **SECTION ONE – PURPOSE:**

The purpose of this Agreement is to provide Local Government Road Funds to Public Entity for the Design w/ Road improvements to various county roads w/ pavement rehabilitation and misc. construction, as described in Project No. SP-3-14(976), Control No. HW2-L300074, and the Public Entity's resolution attached as Appendix C. The Project is a joint and coordinated effort for which the Department and the Public Entity each have authority or jurisdiction. This Agreement shall specify and delineate the rights and duties of the Parties hereto.

## **SECTION TWO -- PROJECT FUNDING BY PARTIES:**

- 1. The estimated total cost for the Project is One hundred fifty two thousand seven hundred dollars (\$152,700.00) to be funded in proportional share by the parties hereto as follows:
  - a. **DEPARTMENT**'s share shall be 75%

\$114,525.00

Design w/ Road improvements to various county roads w/ pavement rehabilitation and misc. construction

b. The Public Entity's required proportional matching

Share shall be 25%

\$38,175.00

For purpose stated above

c. Total Project Cost

\$152,700.00

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2. The Public Entity shall pay all Project costs, which exceed the total amount of One hundred fifty two thousand seven hundred dollars (\$152,700.00).

## SECTION THREE - THE PUBLIC ENTITY SHALL:

- 1. Act in the capacity of lead agency for the purpose as described in Section One.
- 2. Submit an estimate of the Project, including work to be performed and cost to the District Engineer within thirty (30) days of execution of this Agreement, or as otherwise agreed to in writing by the Parties.
- 3. Be solely responsible for all local matching funds identified in Section Two. Certify that these matching funds have been appropriated, budget and approved for expenditure prior to execution of this Agreement.
- 4. Pay all costs, perform/supply or contract for labor and material, for the purpose as described in Section One and the Project estimate approved by the District Engineer.
- 5. In the event a contractor is hired for the Project, require the contractor to have a general liability insurance policy, with limits of liability of at least \$1,000,000 per occurrence. The Department is to be named as an additional insured on the contractor's policy and a certificate of insurance must be provided to the Department and it shall state that coverage provided under the policy is primary over any other valid insurance.
- 6. Require contractors that the Public Entity hires to perform services to defend, indemnify and hold harmless the Department from and against all suits, actions or claims of any character brought because of injury, including death or damages arising out of contractors' construction or maintenance activities pursuant to this agreement, as memorialized herein and subject to any additional permit that may be required of the contractor to perform said activities.
- 7. Be responsible, for performing or directing the performance, of all pre-construction activities, including, but not limited to, the following:
  - a. Utility Certification,
  - b. Drainage and storm drain design,
  - c. Geotechnical design,

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- d. Pavement design,
- e. Environmental and archaeological clearances Certification,
- f. Right of-way acquisition Certification,
- g. Hazardous substance/waste site(s) contamination,
- h. Railroad Certification,
- i. Intelligent Transportation System (ITS) Certification
- 8. Cause all designs and plans to be performed under the direct supervision of a Registered New Mexico Professional Engineer, when applicable, as determined by the Department.
- 9. Obtain all required written agreements or permits, when applicable, from all public and private entities.
- 10. Allow the Department to inspect the Project to determine that the Project is being constructed in accordance with the provisions of this Agreement. Disclosures of any failure to meet such requirements and standards as determined by the Department, shall result in termination, for default, including without limitation the Public Entity's costs for funding, labor, equipment and materials.
- 11. Complete the project within 18 months of the "Notice to Proceed."
- 12. Agree that the Department may terminate this Agreement if the funds identified in Section Two have not been contractually committed within one year from the effective date of this agreement.
- 13. Within thirty (30) days of completion, provide written certification that all work under this Agreement was performed in accordance with either the New Mexico Department of Transportation's Standard Specification, Current Edition; American Public Works Association (APWA) Specifications; Department approved Public Entity established Specifications; or Department Specifications established for Local Government Road Fund projects, by submitting the "Project Certification of Design, Construction, and Cost," form, which is attached as Exhibit A.
- 14. Within thirty (30) days of completion, furnish the Department an "AS BUILT Summary of Costs and Quantities" form, which is attached as Exhibit B. The report should reflect the

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total cost of project as stated in "Project Certification of Design, Construction, and Cost" form.

- 15. Failure to provide the "Project Certification of Design, Construction, and Cost" form and an "AS BUILT Summary of Costs and Quantities" report within thirty (30) days of Project completion will be considered a material breach of this Agreement and Public Entity shall reimburse to the Department all funds disbursed in accordance with this agreement.
- 16. Maintain all facilities constructed or reconstructed with funds provided by this Agreement.

## SECTION FOUR - THE DEPARTMENT SHALL:

Pay project funds as identified in Section Two, Paragraph 1a, to the Public Entity in a single lump sum payment after:

- 1. Receipt of a Notice of Award and Notice to Proceed and,
- 2. Verification of available Local Government Road Funds and Public Entity's local matching funds identified in Section Two, Paragraph 1b.

## **SECTION FIVE - BOTH PARTIES AGREE:**

- Upon termination of this Agreement any remaining property, materials, or equipment belonging to the Department shall be accounted for and disposed of by the Public Entity as directed by the Department.
- 2. That no money in the Local Government Road Fund shall be used by the Department to administer any program, and no entity receiving a distribution pursuant to a program requiring matching funds shall use another distribution made pursuant to NMSA 1978 Section 67-3-28.2, to meet the match required.
- 3. That the provisions of the <u>Local Government Road Fund Project Handbook (Current Edition</u> and any amendments thereto, are incorporated herein by reference and shall control the contractual rights and obligations of the parties unless in conflict with the specific terms expressed in this Agreement or any amendments thereto.

## SECTION SIX - THIRD PARTY BENEFICIARY CLAUSE:

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It is specifically agreed between the parties executing this Agreement that it is not intended by any of the provisions of any part of the Agreement to create in the public, or any member thereof, a third party beneficiary or to authorize anyone not a party to the Agreement to maintain a suit for wrongful death, bodily and/or personal injury to a person, damage to property, and/or any other claim(s) whatsoever pursuant to the provisions of this Agreement.

## <u>SECTION SEVEN - PROJECT RESPONSIBILITY:</u>

The improvements proposed in Section One of this Agreement shall not be under the jurisdiction and control of the Department.

## **SECTION EIGHT – JURISDICTION:**

By reason of the Department's participation in the funding of this Project, the Department is not incorporating this Project into the state highway system, nor is the Department assuming any maintenance or user responsibility of liability for participation on this project.

## SECTION NINE – NEW MEXICO TORT CLAIMS ACT:

Each party shall be responsible for liability arising from personal injury or damage to person and property occasioned by its own agents or employees in the performance of this Agreement, subject in all cases to the immunities and limitations of the New Mexico Tort Claims Act (Section 41-4-1, et seq., NMSA 1978). This paragraph is intended only to define the liabilities between the parties hereto and is not intended to modify, in any way, the parties' liabilities as governed by common law or the New Mexico Tort Claims Act.

The Public Entity and its "employees" as defined in the New Mexico Tort Claims Act, and the Department and its "public employees" as defined in the New Mexico Tort Claims Act, do not waive sovereign immunity, do not waive any defense and/or do not waive any limitation of liability pursuant to law. No provision in this Agreement modifies and/or waives any provision of the New Mexico Tort Claims Act.

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## SECTION TEN - EQUAL OPPORTUNITY COMPLIANCE:

The Public Entity agrees to abide by all applicable Federal and State Laws and rules and regulations, and executive orders of the Governor of the State of New Mexico, pertaining to equal employment opportunity. In accordance with all such laws and rules and regulations, and executive orders of the Governor of the State of New Mexico, the Public Entity agrees to assure that no person in the United States shall, on the grounds of race, color, national origin, sex, sexual preference, age or handicap, be excluded from employment with or participation in, be denied the benefits of, or be otherwise subjected to discrimination under, any program or activity performed under this Agreement. If the Public Entity is found to be not in compliance with these requirements during the life of this Agreement, the Public Entity agrees to take appropriate steps to correct these deficiencies.

## SECTION ELEVEN -LEGAL COMPLIANCE

The Public Entity shall comply with all applicable federal, state, local, and Department laws, regulations and policies in the performance of this Agreement, including, but not limited to laws governing civil right, equal opportunity compliance, environmental issue, workplace safety, employer-employee relations and all other laws governing operations of the workplace, including laws and regulations hereafter enacted. The Public Entity shall ensure that the requirements of this compliance are made a part of each subcontract on this Project at all tiers.

## <u>SECTION TWELVE – PUBLIC ENTITY'S PRIOR COSTS:</u>

Any costs incurred by the Public Entity prior to this Agreement are not eligible for reimbursement and will not be included in the amount to be disbursed as agreed upon.

## SECTION THIRTEEN - ACCOUNTABILITY OF RECEIPTS AND DISBURSEMENTS:

There shall be strict accountability for all receipts and disbursements relating hereto. The Public Entity shall maintain all records and documents relative to the Project for a minimum of three years after completion of the Project. The Public Entity shall furnish the Department and State Auditor, upon demand, any and all such records relevant to this Agreement. If an audit finding determines that specific funding was inappropriate or not related to the Project, the Public Entity shall reimburse

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that portion to the Department within thirty (30) days of written notification. If documentation is insufficient to support an audit by customarily accepted accounting practices, the expense supported by such insufficient documentation shall be reimbursed to the Department within thirty days.

## SECTION FOURTEEN - DEPARTMENT'S AUTHORIZATION OF EXPENDITURES:

The terms of this Agreement are contingent upon sufficient appropriations and authorizations being made by the Legislature of New Mexico, for performance of this Agreement. The Department is expressly not committed to expenditure of any funds until such time as they are budgeted, appropriated by the legislature, and approved for expenditure. The Department's decision as to whether its funds are sufficient for fulfillment of this Agreement shall be final.

## SECTION FIFTEEN - UNEXPENDED, UNENCUMBERED PROJECT BALANCES:

Any unexpended or unencumbered balance from the Local Government Road Fund appropriated for this project shall revert to the Department. These balances, if any, shall be reimbursed to the Department within thirty- (30) days of project completion or expiration of this Agreement, whichever occurs first.

## <u>SECTION SIXTEEN – TERMS OF THIS AGREEMENT:</u>

This Agreement constitutes the entire Agreement between the parties. Any claimed covenant, term, condition, warranty or promise of performance not expressly included in this document or its amendments, is not part of this Agreement and not enforceable pursuant to this Agreement. Performance of all duties and obligations herein shall conform with and shall not contravene any state, local, or federal statues, regulations, rules, or ordinances.

## **SECTION SEVENTEEN – TERM:**

This Agreement becomes effective upon signature of all Parties. This Agreement terminates on December 31, 2014.

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#### **SECTION EIGHTEEN – TERMINATION:**

- 1. If the Public Entity fails to comply with any provision of this Agreement, the Department may terminate this Agreement, by providing 30 days written notice.
- 2. The Department may terminate this Agreement if the funds identified in Section Two have not been contractually committed within one year from the effective date of this agreement.
- 3. If sufficient appropriations and authorizations are not made by the Legislature, this Agreement may terminate immediately upon written notice of the Department to the [Public Entity].
- 4. Neither party shall have any obligation after said date of termination, except as stated in Sections Five, Seven and Eight. The Public Entity agrees to reimburse to the Department all unexpended Department funds disbursed in accordance with this Agreement.

## <u>SECTION NINETEEN – SCOPE OF AGREEMENT:</u>

This Agreement incorporates all the agreements, covenants, and understandings between the parties hereto concerning the subject matter hereof, and all such covenants, agreements and understandings have been merged into this written Agreement. No prior agreement or understandings, verbal or otherwise, of the parties or their agents shall be valid or enforceable unless embodied in this Agreement.

#### **SECTION TWENTY – SEVERABILITY:**

In the event that any portion of this Agreement is determined to be void, unconstitutional or otherwise unenforceable, the remainder of this Agreement shall remain in full force and effect.

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## SECTION TWENTY-ONE - APPLICABLE LAW:

The Laws of the State of New Mexico shall govern this Agreement, without giving effect to its choice of law provisions. Venue shall be proper only in a New Mexico court of competent jurisdiction in accordance with Section 38-3-1(G) NMSA 1978.

## SECTION TWENTY-TWO - AMENDMENT:

28.2 NMSA 1978 and Commission Policy No. 44-12, THE PART	TIES AGREE AS	FOLLOWS:

## **SECTION ONE – PURPOSE:**

The purpose of this Agreement is to provide Local Government Road Funds to Public Entity for the Design w/ Road improvements to various county arterials w/ pavement rehabilitation and misc. construction, as described in Project No. CAP-3-14(496), Control No. HW2-L300073 and the Public Entity's resolution attached as Appendix C. The Project is a joint and coordinated effort for which the Department and the Public Entity each have authority or jurisdiction. This Agreement shall specify and delineate the rights and duties of the Parties hereto.

## **SECTION TWO -- PROJECT FUNDING BY PARTIES:**

- 1. The estimated total cost for the Project is One hundred thirty one thousand seven hundred seventy two dollars (\$131,772.00) to be funded in proportional share by the parties hereto as follows:
  - a. DEPARTMENT's share shall be 75% \$98,829.00
     Design w/ Road improvements to various county arterials w/ pavement rehabilitation and misc. construction
  - b. The Public Entity's required proportional matching

2. The Public Entity shall pay all Project costs, which exceed the total amount of One hundred thirty one thousand seven hundred seventy two dollars (\$131,772.00).

#### SECTION THREE - THE PUBLIC ENTITY SHALL:

- 1. Act in the capacity of lead agency for the purpose as described in Section One.
- 2. Submit an estimate of the Project, including work to be performed and cost to the District Engineer within thirty (30) days of execution of this Agreement, or as otherwise agreed to in writing by the Parties.
- 3. Be solely responsible for all local matching funds identified in Section Two. Certify that these matching funds have been appropriated, budget and approved for expenditure prior to execution of this Agreement.
- 4. Pay all costs, perform/supply or contract for labor and material, for the purpose as described in Section One and the Project estimate approved by the District Engineer.
- 5. In the event a contractor is hired for the Project, require the contractor to have a general liability insurance policy, with limits of liability of at least \$1,000,000 per occurrence. The Department is to be named as an additional insured on the contractor's policy and a certificate of insurance must be provided to the Department and it shall state that coverage provided under the policy is primary over any other valid insurance.
- 6. Require contractors that the Public Entity hires to perform services to defend, indemnify and hold harmless the Department from and against all suits, actions or claims of any character brought because of injury, including death or damages arising out of contractors' construction or maintenance activities pursuant to this agreement, as memorialized herein and subject to any additional permit that may be required of the contractor to perform said activities.
- 7. Be responsible, for performing or directing the performance, of all pre-construction activities, including, but not limited to, the following:

- a. Utility Certification,
- b. Drainage and storm drain design,
- c. Geotechnical design,
- d. Pavement design,
- e. Environmental and archaeological clearances Certification,
- f. Right of-way acquisition Certification,
- g. Hazardous substance/waste site(s) contamination,
- h. Railroad Certification,
- i. Intelligent Transportation System (ITS) Certification
- 8. Cause all designs and plans to be performed under the direct supervision of a Registered New Mexico Professional Engineer, when applicable, as determined by the Department.
- 9. Obtain all required written agreements or permits, when applicable, from all public and private entities.
- 10. Allow the Department to inspect the Project to determine that the Project is being constructed in accordance with the provisions of this Agreement. Disclosures of any failure to meet such requirements and standards as determined by the Department, shall result in termination, for default, including without limitation the Public Entity's costs for funding, labor, equipment and materials.
- 11. Complete the project within 18 months of the "Notice to Proceed."
- 12. Agree that the Department may terminate this Agreement if the funds identified in Section Two have not been contractually committed within one year from the effective date of this agreement.
- 13. Within thirty (30) days of completion, provide written certification that all work under this Agreement was performed in accordance with either the New Mexico Department of Transportation's Standard Specification, Current Edition; American Public Works Association (APWA) Specifications; Department approved Public Entity established Specifications; or Department Specifications established for Local Government Road Fund projects, by submitting the "Project Certification of Design, Construction, and Cost," form, which is attached as Exhibit A.

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- 14. Within thirty (30) days of completion, furnish the Department an "AS BUILT Summary of Costs and Quantities" form, which is attached as Exhibit B. The report should reflect the total cost of project as stated in "Project Certification of Design, Construction, and Cost" form.
- 15. Failure to provide the "Project Certification of Design, Construction, and Cost" form and an "AS BUILT Summary of Costs and Quantities" report within thirty (30) days of Project completion will be considered a material breach of this Agreement and Public Entity shall reimburse to the Department all funds disbursed in accordance with this agreement.
- 16. Maintain all facilities constructed or reconstructed with funds provided by this Agreement.

## SECTION FOUR - THE DEPARTMENT SHALL:

Pay project funds as identified in Section Two, Paragraph 1a, to the Public Entity in a single lump sum payment after:

- 1. Receipt of a Notice of Award and Notice to Proceed and,
- 2. Verification of available Local Government Road Funds and Public Entity's local matching funds identified in Section Two, Paragraph 1b.

#### **SECTION FIVE – BOTH PARTIES AGREE:**

- 1. Upon termination of this Agreement any remaining property, materials, or equipment belonging to the Department shall be accounted for and disposed of by the Public Entity as directed by the Department.
- 2. That no money in the Local Government Road Fund shall be used by the Department to administer any program, and no entity receiving a distribution pursuant to a program requiring matching funds shall use another distribution made pursuant to NMSA 1978 Section 67-3-28.2, to meet the match required.
- 3. That the provisions of the <u>Local Government Road Fund Project Handbook (Current Edition</u> and any amendments thereto, are incorporated herein by reference and shall control the contractual rights and obligations of the parties unless in conflict with the specific terms expressed in this Agreement or any amendments thereto.

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## SECTION SIX - THIRD PARTY BENEFICIARY CLAUSE:

It is specifically agreed between the parties executing this Agreement that it is not intended by any of the provisions of any part of the Agreement to create in the public, or any member thereof, a third party beneficiary or to authorize anyone not a party to the Agreement to maintain a suit for wrongful death, bodily and/or personal injury to a person, damage to property, and/or any other claim(s) whatsoever pursuant to the provisions of this Agreement.

## <u>SECTION SEVEN - PROJECT RESPONSIBILITY:</u>

The improvements proposed in Section One of this Agreement shall not be under the jurisdiction and control of the Department.

#### **SECTION EIGHT – JURISDICTION:**

By reason of the Department's participation in the funding of this Project, the Department is not incorporating this Project into the state highway system, nor is the Department assuming any maintenance or user responsibility of liability for participation on this project.

#### **SECTION NINE - NEW MEXICO TORT CLAIMS ACT:**

Each party shall be responsible for liability arising from personal injury or damage to person and property occasioned by its own agents or employees in the performance of this Agreement, subject in all cases to the immunities and limitations of the New Mexico Tort Claims Act (Section 41-4-1, et seq., NMSA 1978). This paragraph is intended only to define the liabilities between the parties hereto and is not intended to modify, in any way, the parties' liabilities as governed by common law or the New Mexico Tort Claims Act.

The Public Entity and its "employees" as defined in the New Mexico Tort Claims Act, and the Department and its "public employees" as defined in the New Mexico Tort Claims Act, do not waive sovereign immunity, do not waive any defense and/or do not waive any limitation of liability pursuant to law. No provision in this Agreement modifies and/or waives any provision of the New Mexico Tort Claims Act.

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## SECTION TEN - EQUAL OPPORTUNITY COMPLIANCE:

The Public Entity agrees to abide by all applicable Federal and State Laws and rules and regulations, and executive orders of the Governor of the State of New Mexico, pertaining to equal employment opportunity. In accordance with all such laws and rules and regulations, and executive orders of the Governor of the State of New Mexico, the Public Entity agrees to assure that no person in the United States shall, on the grounds of race, color, national origin, sex, sexual preference, age or handicap, be excluded from employment with or participation in, be denied the benefits of, or be otherwise subjected to discrimination under, any program or activity performed under this Agreement. If the Public Entity is found to be not in compliance with these requirements during the life of this Agreement, the Public Entity agrees to take appropriate steps to correct these deficiencies.

## SECTION ELEVEN -LEGAL COMPLIANCE

The Public Entity shall comply with all applicable federal, state, local, and Department laws, regulations and policies in the performance of this Agreement, including, but not limited to laws governing civil right, equal opportunity compliance, environmental issue, workplace safety, employer-employee relations and all other laws governing operations of the workplace, including laws and regulations hereafter enacted. The Public Entity shall ensure that the requirements of this compliance are made a part of each subcontract on this Project at all tiers.

## SECTION TWELVE - PUBLIC ENTITY'S PRIOR COSTS:

Any costs incurred by the Public Entity prior to this Agreement are not eligible for reimbursement and will not be included in the amount to be disbursed as agreed upon.

## <u>SECTION THIRTEEN - ACCOUNTABILITY OF RECEIPTS AND DISBURSEMENTS:</u>

There shall be strict accountability for all receipts and disbursements relating hereto. The Public Entity shall maintain all records and documents relative to the Project for a minimum of three years after completion of the Project. The Public Entity shall furnish the Department and State Auditor, upon demand, any and all such records relevant to this Agreement. If an audit finding determines

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that specific funding was inappropriate or not related to the Project, the Public Entity shall reimburse that portion to the Department within thirty (30) days of written notification. If documentation is insufficient to support an audit by customarily accepted accounting practices, the expense supported by such insufficient documentation shall be reimbursed to the Department within thirty days.

## SECTION FOURTEEN - DEPARTMENT'S AUTHORIZATION OF EXPENDITURES:

The terms of this Agreement are contingent upon sufficient appropriations and authorizations being made by the Legislature of New Mexico, for performance of this Agreement. The Department is expressly not committed to expenditure of any funds until such time as they are budgeted, appropriated by the legislature, and approved for expenditure. The Department's decision as to whether its funds are sufficient for fulfillment of this Agreement shall be final.

#### SECTION FIFTEEN - UNEXPENDED, UNENCUMBERED PROJECT BALANCES:

Any unexpended or unencumbered balance from the Local Government Road Fund appropriated for this project shall revert to the Department. These balances, if any, shall be reimbursed to the Department within thirty- (30) days of project completion or expiration of this Agreement, whichever occurs first.

#### **SECTION SIXTEEN – TERMS OF THIS AGREEMENT:**

This Agreement constitutes the entire Agreement between the parties. Any claimed covenant, term, condition, warranty or promise of performance not expressly included in this document or its amendments, is not part of this Agreement and not enforceable pursuant to this Agreement. Performance of all duties and obligations herein shall conform with and shall not contravene any state, local, or federal statues, regulations, rules, or ordinances.

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#### **SECTION SEVENTEEN – TERM:**

This Agreement becomes effective upon signature of all Parties. This Agreement terminates on December 31, 2014.

## **SECTION EIGHTEEN – TERMINATION:**

- 1. If the Public Entity fails to comply with any provision of this Agreement, the Department may terminate this Agreement, by providing 30 days written notice.
- The Department may terminate this Agreement if the funds identified in Section Two have not been contractually committed within one year from the effective date of this agreement.
- 3. If sufficient appropriations and authorizations are not made by the Legislature, this Agreement may terminate immediately upon written notice of the Department to the [Public Entity].
- 4. Neither party shall have any obligation after said date of termination, except as stated in Sections Five, Seven and Eight. The Public Entity agrees to reimburse to the Department all unexpended Department funds disbursed in accordance with this Agreement.

## <u>SECTION NINETEEN – SCOPE OF AGREEMENT:</u>

This Agreement incorporates all the agreements, covenants, and understandings between the parties hereto concerning the subject matter hereof, and all such covenants, agreements and understandings have been merged into this written Agreement. No prior agreement or understandings, verbal or otherwise, of the parties or their agents shall be valid or enforceable unless embodied in this Agreement.

## **SECTION TWENTY – SEVERABILITY:**

In the event that any portion of this Agreement is determined to be void, unconstitutional or otherwise unenforceable, the remainder of this Agreement shall remain in full force and effect.

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## SECTION TWENTY-ONE - APPLICABLE LAW:

The Laws of the State of New Mexico shall govern this Agreement, without giving effect to its choice of law provisions. Venue shall be proper only in a New Mexico court of competent jurisdiction in accordance with Section 38-3-1(G) NMSA 1978.

## **SECTION TWENTY-TWO – AMENDMENT:**

This Agreement shall not be altered, modified, or amended except by an instrument in writing and executed by the parties hereto.

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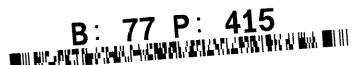

#### CONTRACT

#### VALENCIA COUNTY

#### CONTRACT #VCR-FY14-009

THIS AGREEMENT is made and entered into by and between the County of Valencia, hereinafter referred to as the "County" and Correctional Healthcare Companies, Inc., hereinafter referred to as the "Contractor", and is effective on January 1, 2014 or on the date set forth below upon which it is executed by the Purchasing Agent and the Board of County Commissioners, whichever is later.

## IT IS AGREED BETWEEN THE PARTIES:

#### 1. Scope of Work.

The Contractor shall perform the work outlined in the Scope of Work attached hereto as **Attachment 1** and incorporated herein by reference.

#### 2. Compensation.

- A. The County shall pay to the Contractor in full payment for services satisfactorily performed six hundred sixty eight thousand one hundred seventy eight dollars and sixty eight cents (\$668,178.68), excluding gross receipts tax. The New Mexico gross receipts tax levied on the amounts payable under this Agreement totaling fifty thousand five hundred thirty one dollars and one cent (\$50,530.01) shall be paid by the County to the Contractor. The total amount payable to the Contractor under this Agreement, including gross receipts tax is seven hundred eighteen thousand seven hundred nine and sixty nine cents (\$718,709.69). In no event will the Contractor be paid for services provided in excess of the total compensation amount without this Agreement being amended in writing prior to those services in excess of the total compensation amount being provided. Compensation to be paid for any contract period, beyond the initial term and if exercised, shall be by mutual agreement of the parties.
- B. Payment is subject to availability of funds pursuant to the Appropriations Paragraph set forth below and to any negotiations between the parties from year to year pursuant to Paragraph 1, Scope of Work. All invoices MUST BE received by the County no later than fifteen (15) days after the termination of the Fiscal Year in which the services were delivered. Invoices received after such date WILL NOT BE PAID.
- C. Contractor must submit a detailed statement accounting for all services performed and expenses incurred no more frequently than once per month. If the County finds that the services are not acceptable, within thirty days after the date of receipt of written notice from the Contractor that payment is requested, it shall provide the Contractor a letter of exception explaining the defect or objection to the services, and outlining steps the Contractor may take to provide remedial action. Upon certification by the County that the services have been received

and accepted, payment shall be tendered to the Contractor within thirty days after the date of acceptance. If payment is made by mail, the payment shall be deemed tendered on the date it is postmarked. However, the County shall not incur late charges, interest, or penalties for failure to make payment within the time specified herein.

D. The payment of taxes due for any money received under this Agreement shall be the Contractor's sole responsibility and shall be reported under the Contractor's Federal and State tax identification number(s).

#### 3. Term.

This Agreement shall terminate on December 31, 2014 unless terminated pursuant to paragraph 4 (Termination), or paragraph 5 (Appropriations). The term of this Agreement may be extended on an annual basis, or any portion thereof, by mutual agreement of the parties for up to three (3) additional years. In accordance with Section 13-1-150 NMSA 1978, no contract term for a professional services contract, including extensions and renewals, shall exceed four years, except as set forth in Section 13-1-150 NMSA 1978.

#### 4. <u>Termination</u>.

- Α. Termination. This Agreement may be terminated by either of the parties hereto upon written notice delivered to the other party at least thirty (30) days prior to the intended date of termination. Except as otherwise allowed or provided under this Agreement, the County's sole liability upon such termination shall be to pay for acceptable work performed prior to the Contractor's receipt of the notice of termination, if the County is the terminating party, or the Contractor's sending of the notice of termination, if the Contractor is the terminating party; provided, however, that a notice of termination shall not nullify or otherwise affect either party's liability for pre-termination defaults under or breaches of this Agreement. The Contractor shall submit an invoice for such work within thirty (30) days of receiving or sending the notice of termination. Notwithstanding the foregoing, this Agreement may be terminated immediately upon written notice to the Contractor if the Contractor becomes unable to perform the services contracted for, as determined by the County or if, during the term of this Agreement, the Contractor or any of its officers, employees or agents is indicted for fraud, embezzlement or other crime due to misuse of government funds or due to the Appropriations paragraph herein. THIS PROVISION IS NOT EXCLUSIVE AND DOES NOT WAIVE THE STATE'S OTHER LEGAL RIGHTS REMEDIES CAUSED AND BY THE CONTRACTOR'S DEFAULT/BREACH OF THIS AGREEMENT.
- B Termination Management. Immediately upon receipt by either the County or the Contractor of notice of termination of this Agreement, the Contractor shall: 1) not incur any further obligations for salaries, services or any other expenditure of funds under this Agreement without written approval of the County; 2) comply with all directives issued by the County in the notice of termination as to the performance of work under this Agreement; and 3) take such action as the County shall direct for the protection, preservation, retention or transfer of all property titled to the County and records generated under this Agreement. Any non-expendable personal property or equipment provided to or purchased by the Contractor with contract funds shall become property of the County upon termination and shall be submitted to the County as soon as practicable.

#### 5. Appropriations.

The terms of this Agreement are contingent upon sufficient appropriations and authorization being made by the Board of County Commissioners for the performance of this Agreement. If sufficient appropriations and authorization are not made by the Board of County Commissioners, this Agreement shall terminate immediately upon written notice being given by the County to the Contractor. The County's decision as to whether sufficient appropriations are available shall be accepted by the Contractor and shall be final. If the County proposes an amendment to the Agreement to unilaterally reduce funding, the Contractor shall have the option to terminate the Agreement or to agree to the reduced funding, within thirty (30) days of receipt of the proposed amendment.

#### 6. Status of Contractor.

The Contractor and its agents and employees are independent contractors performing professional services for the County and are not employees of the County of Valencia. The Contractor and its agents and employees shall not accrue leave, retirement, insurance, bonding, use of county vehicles, or any other benefits afforded to employees of the County of Valencia as a result of this Agreement. The Contractor acknowledges that all sums received hereunder are reportable by the Contractor for tax purposes, including without limitation, self-employment and business income tax. The Contractor agrees not to purport to bind the County of Valencia unless the Contractor has express written authority to do so, and then only within the strict limits of that authority.

#### 7. <u>Assignment.</u>

The Contractor shall not assign or transfer any interest in this Agreement or assign any claims for money due or to become due under this Agreement without the prior written approval of the County.

#### 8. Subcontracting.

The Contractor shall not subcontract any portion of the services to be performed under this Agreement without the prior written approval of the County. No such subcontract shall relieve the primary Contractor from its obligations and liabilities under this Agreement, nor shall any subcontract obligate direct payment from the County. In all cases, the Contractor is solely responsible for fulfillment of this Agreement.

#### 9. Release.

Final payment of the amounts due under this Agreement shall operate as a release of the procuring agency of the County, its officers and employees, and the County of Valencia from all liabilities, claims and obligations whatsoever arising from or under this Agreement.

## 10. Confidentiality.

Any confidential information provided to or developed by the Contractor in the performance of this Agreement shall be kept confidential and shall not be made available to any individual or organization by the Contractor without the prior written approval of the County.

### 11. Product of Service -- Copyright.

All materials developed or acquired by the Contractor under this Agreement shall become the property of the County of Valencia and shall be delivered to the County no later than the termination date of this Agreement. Nothing developed or produced, in whole or in part, by the Contractor under this Agreement shall be the subject of an application for copyright or other claim of ownership by or on behalf of the Contractor.

#### 12. Conflict of Interest; Governmental Conduct Act.

- A. The Contractor represents and warrants that it presently has no interest and, during the term of this Agreement, shall not acquire any interest, direct or indirect, which would conflict in any manner or degree with the performance or services required under the Agreement.
- B. The Contractor further represents and warrants that it has complied with, and, during the term of this Agreement, will continue to comply with, and that this Agreement complies with all applicable provisions of the Governmental Conduct Act, Chapter 10, Article 16 NMSA 1978. Without in anyway limiting the generality of the foregoing, the Contractor specifically represents and warrants that:
- 1) in accordance with Section 10-16-4.3 NMSA 1978, the Contractor does not employ, has not employed, and will not employ during the term of this Agreement any County employee while such employee was or is employed by the County and participating directly or indirectly in the County's contracting process;
- this Agreement complies with Section 10-16-7(B) NMSA 1978 because (i) the Contractor is not a public officer or employee of the County; (ii) the Contractor is not a member of the family of a public officer or employee or the family of a public officer or employee has a substantial interest; or (iv) if the Contractor is a public officer or employee of the County, a member of the family of a public officer or employee of the County, or a business in which a public officer or employee of the County or the family of a public officer or employee of the County has a substantial interest, public notice was given as required by Section 10-16-7(B) NMSA 1978 and this Agreement was awarded pursuant to a competitive process;
- 3) in accordance with Section 10-16-8(C) NMSA 1978, (i) the Contractor is not, and has not been represented by, a person who has been a public officer or employee of the County within the preceding year and whose official act directly resulted in this Agreement and (ii) the Contractor is not, and has not been assisted in any way regarding this transaction by, a former public officer or employee of the County whose official act, while in County employment, directly resulted in the County's making this Agreement;
- 4) in accordance with Section 10-16-13 NMSA 1978, the Contractor has not directly participated in the preparation of specifications, qualifications or evaluation criteria for this Agreement or any procurement related to this Agreement; and
- 5) in accordance with Section 10-16-3 and Section 10-16-13.3 NMSA 1978, the Contractor has not contributed, and during the term of this Agreement shall not contribute, anything of value to a public officer or employee of the County.
- C. Contractor's representations and warranties in Paragraphs A and B of this Article 12 are material representations of fact upon which the County relied when this Agreement was entered into by the parties. Contractor shall provide immediate written notice to the County if, at

 any time during the term of this Agreement, Contractor learns that Contractor's representations and warranties in Paragraphs A and B of this Article 12 were erroneous on the effective date of this Agreement or have become erroneous by reason of new or changed circumstances. If it is later determined that Contractor's representations and warranties in Paragraphs A and B of this Article 12 were erroneous on the effective date of this Agreement or have become erroneous by reason of new or changed circumstances, in addition to other remedies available to the County and notwithstanding anything in the Agreement to the contrary, the County may immediately terminate the Agreement.

D. All terms defined in the Governmental Conduct Act have the same meaning in this Article 12(B).

#### 13. Amendment.

- A. This Agreement shall not be altered, changed or amended except by instrument in writing executed by the parties hereto and all other required signatories.
- B. If the County proposes an amendment to the Agreement to unilaterally reduce funding due to budget or other considerations, the Contractor shall, within thirty (30) days of receipt of the proposed Amendment, have the option to terminate the Agreement, pursuant to the termination provisions as set forth in Article 4 herein, or to agree to the reduced funding.

#### 14. Merger.

This Agreement incorporates all the Agreements, covenants and understandings between the parties hereto concerning the subject matter hereof, and all such covenants, Agreements and understandings have been merged into this written Agreement. No prior Agreement or understanding, oral or otherwise, of the parties or their agents shall be valid or enforceable unless embodied in this Agreement.

## 15. <u>Penalties for Violation of Law.</u>

The Procurement Code, Sections 13-1-28 through 13-1-199, NMSA 1978, imposes civil and criminal penalties for its violation. In addition, the New Mexico criminal statutes impose felony penalties for illegal bribes, gratuities and kickbacks.

## 16. Equal Opportunity Compliance.

The Contractor agrees to abide by all federal, state and county laws and rules and regulations, pertaining to equal employment opportunity. In accordance with all such laws, the Contractor assures that no person in the United States shall, on the grounds of race, religion, color, national origin, ancestry, sex, age, physical or mental handicap, or serious medical condition, spousal affiliation, sexual orientation or gender identity, be excluded from employment with or participation in, be denied the benefits of, or be otherwise subjected to discrimination under any program or activity performed under this Agreement. If Contractor is found not to be in compliance with these requirements during the life of this Agreement, Contractor agrees to take appropriate steps to correct these deficiencies.

#### 17. Applicable Law.

The laws of the State of New Mexico shall govern this Agreement and shall be enforceable in the Thirteenth Judicial District Court in Valencia County. By execution of this Agreement, Contractor acknowledges and agrees to the jurisdiction of the courts of the State of New Mexico over any and all lawsuits arising under or out of any term of this Agreement.

#### 18. Workers Compensation.

The Contractor agrees to comply with state laws and rules applicable to workers compensation benefits for its employees. If the Contractor fails to comply with the Workers Compensation Act and applicable rules when required to do so, this Agreement may be terminated by the County.

#### 19. Records and Financial Audit.

The Contractor shall maintain detailed time and expenditure records that indicate the date; time, nature and cost of services rendered during the Agreement's term and effect and retain them for a period of three (3) years from the date of final payment under this Agreement. The records shall be subject to inspection by the County, the Department of Finance and Administration and the State Auditor. The County shall have the right to audit billings both before and after payment. Payment under this Agreement shall not foreclose the right of the County to recover excessive or illegal payments

### 20. <u>Disclaimer and Hold Harmless.</u>

The Valencia County shall not be liable to the Contractor, or the Contractor's successors, heirs, administrators, or assigns, for any loss, damage, or injury, whether to Contractor's person or property, occurring in connection with Contractor's performance of Contractor's duties according to this Agreement. Contractor shall hold the Valencia County harmless from all loss, damage, and injury, including court costs and attorney fees, incurred by Valencia County in connection with the performance by Contractor of Contractor's duties according to this Agreement.

### 21. <u>Insurance Coverage.</u>

- A. Coverage. The Contractor shall, at its sole cost and expense, procure and maintain during the term of this Agreement, the following coverage and limits of insurance:
  - 1) Medical Malpractice/Professional Liability. Medical Malpractice/ Professional Liability insurance in an amount not less than \$2,000,000 per occurrence and \$5,000,000 in the aggregate.
  - 2) Comprehensive General Liability. Comprehensive General Liability insurance in an amount not less than \$2,000,000 per occurrence and \$5,000,000 in the aggregate.
  - 3) Worker's Compensation. Worker's Compensation coverage as required by applicable state law.

- B. Endorsements. The Comprehensive General Liability policy shall contain additional endorsements naming Valencia County as an additional insured with respect to liabilities arising out of the performance of services under this Agreement.
- C. Proof of Insurance. The Contractor shall provide the County proof of professional liability or medical malpractice coverage for the Contractor's health care staff, employees, agents and subcontractors, for the term services are provided under this Agreement. The Contractor shall promptly notify the County, in writing, of each change in coverage, reduction in policy amounts or cancellation of insurance coverage. If the Contractor fails to provide proof of adequate insurance within a reasonable time under the circumstances, then the County shall be entitled to terminate this Agreement without penalty to the County pursuant to the termination provision of this Agreement.

#### 22. <u>Indemnification.</u>

The Contractor shall defend, indemnify and hold harmless the County of Valencia from all actions, proceeding, claims, demands, costs, damages, attorneys' fees and all other liabilities and expenses of any kind from any source which may arise out of the performance of this Agreement, caused by the negligent act or failure to act of the Contractor, its officers, employees, servants, subcontractors or agents, or if caused by the actions of any client of the Contractor resulting in injury or damage to persons or property during the time when the Contractor or any officer, agent, employee, servant or subcontractor thereof has or is performing services pursuant to this Agreement. In the event that any action, suit or proceeding related to the services performed by the Contractor or any officer, agent, employee, servant or subcontractor under this Agreement is brought against the Contractor, the Contractor shall, as soon as practicable but no later than two (2) days after it receives notice thereof, notify the legal counsel of the County of Valencia and the New Mexico Association of Counties by certified mail.

#### 23. <u>Invalid Term or Condition.</u>

If any term or condition of this Agreement shall be held invalid or unenforceable, the remainder of this Agreement shall not be affected and shall be valid and enforceable.

#### 24. Enforcement of Agreement.

A party's failure to require strict performance of any provision of this Agreement shall not waive or diminish that party's right thereafter to demand strict compliance with that or any other provision. No waiver by a party of any of its rights under this Agreement shall be effective unless express and in writing, and no effective waiver by a party of any of its rights shall be effective to waive any other rights.

#### 25. Authority.

If Contractor is other than a natural person, the individual(s) signing this Agreement on behalf of Contractor represents and warrants that he or she has the power and authority to bind Contractor, and that no further action, resolution, or approval from Contractor is necessary to enter into a binding contract.

#### 26. Lobbying.

No federal appropriated funds can be paid or will be paid, by or on behalf of the CONTRACTOR, or any person for influencing or attempting to influence an officer or employee of any County, a Member of Congress, an officer or employee of Congress, or an employee of a Member of Congress in connection with the awarding of any Federal contract, or the making of any Federal grant, the making of any federal loan, the entering into of any cooperative agreement, or modification of any Federal contract, grant, loan, or cooperative agreement. If any funds other than federal appropriated funds have been paid or will be paid to any person influencing or attempting to influence an officer or employee of any County, a Member of Congress, an officer or employee of Congress, or an employee of a Member of Congress in connection of this federal contract, grant, loan, or cooperative agreement, the CONTRACTOR shall complete and submit Standard Form LLL, "Disclosure Form to Report Lobbying," in accordance with its instructions.

#### 27. Approval of Contractor Personnel.

Personnel proposed in the Contractor's written proposal to the County are considered material to any work performed under this Agreement. No changes of personnel will be made by the Contractor without prior written consent of the procuring agency of the County. Replacement of any Contractor personnel, if approved, shall be with personnel of equal ability, experience and qualifications. The Contractor will be responsible for any expenses incurred in familiarizing the replacement personnel to insure their being productive to the project immediately upon receiving assignments. Approval of replacement personnel shall not be unreasonably withheld. The procuring agency of the County shall retain the right to request the removal of any of the Contractor's personnel at any time.

## 28. <u>Limit of Liability.</u>

The Contractor's liability to the County for any cause whatsoever shall be limited to the purchase price paid to the Contractor for the products and services that are the subject of County's claim. The foregoing limitation does not apply to the paragraphs entitled "Indemnification" and "Patent, Copyright, Trademark and Trade Secret Indemnification" of this Agreement or to damages resulting from personal injury caused by the Contractor's negligence.

In no event will the Contractor be liable for any damages resulting from loss of data or use, lost profits or any incidental or consequential damages.

## 29. Survival.

The Agreement paragraphs titled "Patent, Copyright, Trademark, and Trade Secret Indemnification"; "Indemnification"; and "Limit of Liability" shall survive the expiration of this Agreement. Software licenses, leases, maintenance and any other unexpired agreements that were entered into under the terms and conditions of this Agreement shall survive this Agreement

#### 30. Succession.

This Agreement shall extend to and be binding upon the successors and assigns of the parties.

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#### 31. Force Majeure.

A party shall be excused from performance under this Agreement for any period that the party is prevented from performing as a result of an act of God, strike, war, civil disturbance, epidemic, or court order, provided that the party has prudently and promptly acted to take any and all steps that are within the party's control to ensure performance. Subject to this provision, such non-performance shall not be deemed a default or a ground for termination.

#### 32. Mediation.

In the event a dispute arises as to the rights and obligations among the parties hereto, the parties agree to attempt to resolve the dispute through mediation as a condition precedent to seeking legal and equitable remedies. The parties agree to evenly split the costs of any such mediation services. The parties shall mutually agree upon the choice of mediator. In the event the parties have not agreed upon a mediator within twenty (20) days of written notice to the other regarding the dispute, then a list of seven potential mediators will be obtained from the New Mexico Association of Counties and the parties shall utilize a striking process until a mediator is agreed upon.

### 33. Notice to Proceed.

It is expressly understood that this Agreement is not binding upon the County until it is executed by the Board of County Commissioners after voting on the contract at a public meeting or unless it is executed by the Valencia County Manager, if the amount of the contract is \$5,000.00 or less, further, that the Contractor is not to proceed with its obligations under the Agreement until the Contractor has received a fully signed copy of the Agreement.

#### 34. Attorney's Fees.

In the event this Agreement results in dispute, mediation, litigation, or settlement between the parties to this Agreement, the prevailing party of such action shall NOT be entitled to an award of attorneys' fees and court costs.

#### 35. <u>Cooperation.</u>

All parties hereto will fully cooperate with the other and their respective counsel, accountant, and agents in connection with any steps required to be taken under this Agreement.

#### 36. Incorporation and Order of Precedence.

Request for Proposals No. VCR-FY14-009 and the Contractor's proposal are incorporated by reference into this Agreement and are made a part of this Agreement. In the event of any conflict among these documents, the following order of precedence shall apply:

- 1. Any contract amendment(s), in reverse chronological order; then
- 2. this contract itself; then
- 3. the Request for Proposals; then
- 4. the Contractors Best and Final Offer(s), in reverse chronological order; then
- 5. the Contractor's proposal; then
- 6. the Contractor's standard agreement terms and conditions (which may or may not have been submitted as part of the Contractor's proposal).

#### 37. Patent, Copyright, Trademark and Trade Secret Indemnification.

- The Contractor shall defend, at its own expense, the County of Valencia against any claim that any product or service provided under this Agreement infringes any patent, copyright or trademark in the United States or Puerto Rico, and shall pay all costs, damages and attorneys' fees that a court finally awards as a result of any such claim. In addition, if any third party obtains a judgment against the County of Valencia based upon the Contractor's trade secret infringement relating to any product or service provided under this Agreement, the Contractor agrees to reimburse the County of Valencia for all costs, attorneys' fees and the amount of the judgment. To qualify for such defense and/or payment, the County of Valencia shall:
  - ì. give the Contractor prompt written notice of any claim;
  - ii. allow the Contractor to control the defense or settlement of the claim; and
- cooperate with the Contractor in a reasonable way to facilitate the defense or iii. settlement of the claim.
- If any product or service becomes, or in the Contractor's opinion is likely to become the subject of a claim of infringement, the Contractor shall at its option and expense:
- provide a procuring agency of the County the right to continue using the product or service;
  - ii. replace or modify the product or service so that it becomes non-infringing; or
- accept the return of the product or service and refund an amount equal to the depreciated value of the returned product or service, less the unpaid portion of the purchase price and any other amounts which are due to the Contractor. The Contractor's obligation will be void as to any product or service modified by the procuring agency of the County to the extent such modification is the cause of the claim.

## Contractor's Payment of Property Taxes.

Contractor acknowledges that County has established a policy of ensuring that all individuals and businesses that benefit financially from County through contract are current in paying their property tax obligations to mitigate the economic burden otherwise imposed upon County and its taxpayers. Contractor warrants and certifies that it is presently not delinquent in the payment of its property tax obligations, and that it will not become delinquent during the term of this Contract.

#### 39. Termination For Failure to Comply with County's Tax Reduction Policy.

Without limiting the rights and remedies available to County under any other provision of this contract, failure of Contractor to cure a property tax delinquency within 10 days of notice shall be grounds upon which County may terminate this Contract.

#### 40. Notices.

Any notice required to be given to either party by this Agreement shall be in writing and shall be delivered in person, by courier service or by U.S. mail, either first class or certified, return receipt requested, postage prepaid, as follows:
